Mandatory Uniform Policy

- You may purchase your uniform from any store which carries actual school uniform pieces. This would include (but is not limited to) the uniform departments of Sears, K-Mart, JCPenney's, Wal-Mart, Beall's, the GAP and Target. **Regardless of what pieces and styles are sold in these Uniform Departments, our uniforms must comply with the following rules and regulations.**
- There is no uniform shoe, however, shoes must have a closed toe and a back. No high heels, boots, sneaker-skates, crocs or sandals are permitted. All shoes must be properly fastened. (i.e. shoelaces tied, Velcro closed, etc.) Socks or tights are required. Remember, the students have PE every day.
- Choose one uniform piece from Column A and one or more pieces from Column B.
- The current year's Diplomat School T-shirt may be worn on Fridays with a proper uniform main piece.
- Outer jackets for cool days do not need to be uniform, however, if you wish to wear a sweater or sweatshirt in the classroom, it must be a uniform color with no printing or design except our school logo.
- Shirts must be worn tucked in. Pants/Shorts must be worn at the waist.

Main Uniform Piece (Choose Only Khaki or Navy Blue)	Uniform Shirt/Blouse/Sweater/Sweatshirt (Choose Only White, Light Blue, Red, Light Yellow, Gray or Navy Blue)
Pants – no cargo pants	Short or Long Sleeved Collared Golf Shirts
Shorts (below fingertip length) or Capris – no cargo styles	Short or Long Sleeved button-down Collared Shirts
Skorts	Short or Long Sleeved Collared Blouses
Pleated jumper	Long Sleeved Turtleneck Shirts
Plain jumper	Pullover sweaters or sweatshirts (optional for cooler weather)
Skirts	Cardigan sweaters (optional for cooler weather)

Parents will be called to pick up their student or bring proper clothing if the student is found to be in violation of the mandatory uniform policy.

Forbidden: No cargo pants/shorts nor jeans/dungarees. This means no patch-type "cargo" pockets or "hammer" loops, no grommets, no snaps, no denim (even if it is the proper color).
 No patterns, stripes, or prints on anything. All pieces should be solid-colored.
 No bright blue, cobalt blue, cranberry, pink, maroon, orange, bright gold, green or beige anything. You must choose from our designated uniform colors.
 No T-shirts -- all shirts must have a collar. (Exception: The current year's Friday school t-shirts)
 No logos or brand-name symbols may be visible on any clothing.
 No unnatural hair color, hair extensions, wigs, hair pieces or hair add-ons.
 No fake fingernails, no make-up, no tattoos – whether temporary or permanent.
 No dangling earrings or excessive jewelry (amount or size) and no gauging.
 No hats or scarves or sunglasses or gloves.
 No rolling backpacks.

Any article of clothing, jewelry or accessory, which in the judgment of School administration is a distraction or hindrance to classroom learning and/or activities or poses a safety hazard, can be forbidden at the discretion of Administration without prior warning.
